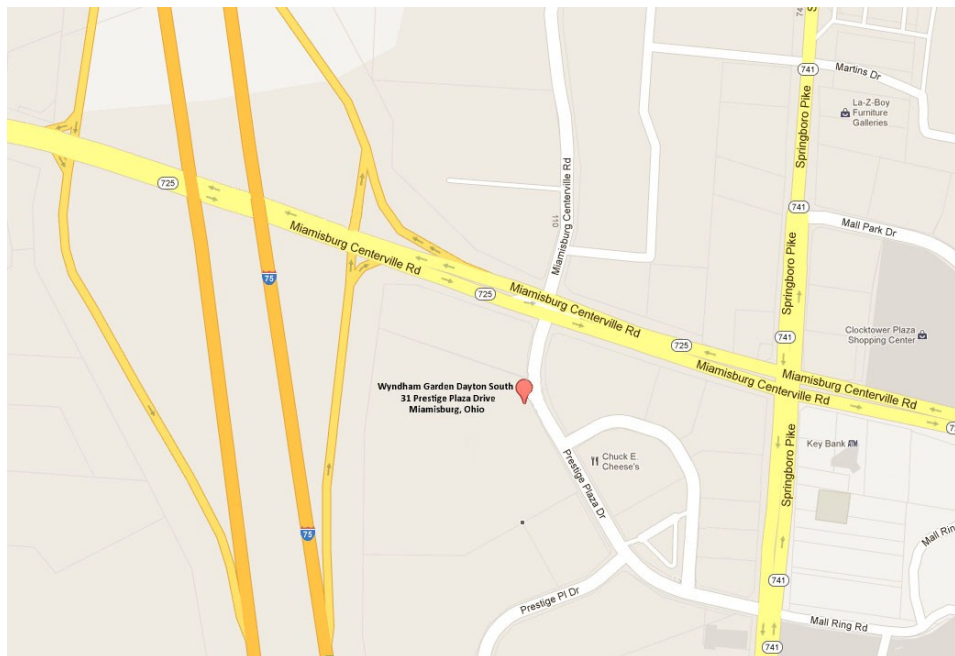

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular (Additional Classes) Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owners of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. An entry fee of \$22.00 (including \$2.00 Service and Recording Fee) will be charged for each dog making up the entry (Stud Dog and two of its Get) if they are not entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed Competition, or some Non-Regular Class (other than Stud Dog).

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these Classes will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the Class.

Brace Class - (two, identical ownership) will require a fee of \$8.00 as a UNIT. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", fee \$22.00 (including \$2.00 AKC Event Service and Recording Fee) per dog plus \$8.00 for the unit. In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class - "Brace Class".

Awards of Merit - Awards of Merit are offered by the Scottish Terrier Club of Greater Dayton. This Award of Merit is a Rosette to recognize outstanding champions, EXCLUDING those selected for Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. The fee for Sweepstakes entry shall be \$10.00. Both entries (regular and sweeps) for each puppy shall be made on one official form accompanied with the fee for both. The entry in Sweepstakes must be noted on the official entry form under the heading "Additional Classes". Sweepstakes classes will be judged before the regular classes.

THERE WILL BE NO GROOMING IN THE HOTEL ROOMS. DO NOT LEAVE DOGS UNATTENDED IN YOUR ROOM. Plastic will be available in the Hotel Lobby to be used under crates. Only dogs entered are to be brought to the hotel.

The show area will be open to exhibitors on Saturday, March 31, 2012 at 7:00 A.M.

Dogs need not be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Consult judging program for time of judging.

Use of exercise pens will be allowed in the show area. Rough grooming, stripping, plucking or trimming will be allowed in the show area.

All prizes, ribbons, and trophies must be claimed the day of the show; otherwise they become the sole property of the Scottish Terrier Club of Greater Dayton. No trophies will be mailed.

Notice to Exhibitors

- AKC Event Service and Recording fee of \$2.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chap. 11, Sec. 2)
- Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of any conformation judging at the show. (AKC Rule, Chap. 11, Sec. 6)

SCHEDULE OF POINTS FOR DIVISION 5

Illinois, Indiana, Michigan & Ohio

Championship points will be recorded according to the number of eligible entries competing in the regular classes of each sex in the breed or variety, and according to the Schedule of Points established by the Board of Directors.

If an entry is designated Winners Dog or Winner Bitch is also awarded Best of Breed or, the entries of both sexes that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition and that have been defeated in such competition, shall be counted in addition to the entries that competed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

If an entry is designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety, the entries of its own sex that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition and have been defeated in competition for Best of Opposite Sex shall be counted in addition to the entries that competed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

The entry awarded the Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

In counting the number of eligible entries in competition, an entry that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

A Scottie which shall have won 15 points shall become a Champion of Record, if six or more of said points shall have been won at two shows with a rating of 3 or more championship points each and under two different judges, and some one or more of the balance of said points shall have been won under some other judge or judges than the two judges referred to above.

Your Scottish Terrier becomes a champion when it is so officially recorded by AKC and when registered in the Stud Book shall be entitled to a championship certificate.
