President Gary Stroede called the meeting to order in Packy's at the Hope Hotel at 1:07 p.m.

Recording Secretary Sue Stacy read the minutes from the April 16<sup>th</sup> meeting. Sandy Maddux said she did not remember saying she would contact Rita about the calendar so Sue said she would take that sentence out. The remaining minutes were accepted as read.

There was no Corresponding Secretary report.

Because Cheryl Bates could not be at the meeting, Sue Stacy read her report. She had picked up a young male Scottie who was originally fostered by Susan Coffield but then went to Peggy Pearce and Don Riepenhoff who were working with him on some issues he was having. The dog was originally a puppy mill dog and was never on grass until he was three months old. Sue also reported on the meeting she had with Barbara Bates of the Hope Hotel regarding our contracts for 2018 and 2019. Peg left a space for a saying we can add and it was suggested perhaps "STCA-STCGD Specialties 2017" would be appropriate. Pam Williams is taking care of items for the Rotating. Angie Anastasia had brought the catalog from the company where she has gotten shirts and hats in the past. It was agreed that the club should invest in items that have our logo on them for sale to members. Susan Moloney presented the illustration of the wine glasses that will be imprinted with our logo to be used as table favors for the banquet. Members liked the idea that we will order more than we need so that if people want to make up a full set, they will be available for purchase. Angie said she is waiting for one more quilt square in order to move on to the next step. Peg Pearce has asked that a "Centerpiece Assembly Party" be set up sometime this summer so the centerpieces that need to go to Rotating in Montgomery can be completed.

There was a great deal of discussion on the Ways and Means Committee. No one is quite sure who is Chair, but it was agreed that it is necessary to get started on some of the projects like the door mats while the weather is warm. Any other ideas for projects will be greatly appreciated.

There was no Sunshine report.

Voting for the 2016 Good Sportsmanship Award took place and the winner will be announced at the September meeting.

No meeting date for June has been set.

Jeff Underwood moved and Sandy Maddux seconded a motion that the meeting be adjourned. The motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 1:45 p.m.
