President Gary Stroede called the meeting to order at 1:48 p.m. at Fairborn Community Park in Fairborn, Ohio.

Recording Secretary Sue Stacy read the minutes from the August 8, 2015, meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

Corresponding Secretary Pam Williams had no report.

Sunshine Chair Susan Jackson reported she had sent several cards this past month. Get well cards were sent to Jack Anastasia and Bill Pool, sympathy cards to Steve Sayre (mother), Gary and Kim Stroede (Candy and Gabriel) and Marilyn and Eddie Lindsay (Lydia), and a thank you to Cass Ridgley for her generous gift of old Scottie books for us to auction.

Rescue Coordinator Cheryl Bates reported that Pebbles, the little girl that had had so many problems when she came into Rescue is now healthy and has been adopted. Cheryl also announced that Lacey, the little girl that had been fostered by Sandy Maddux, has passed away, and that because of a decline in Walt Berninger's health, Lucy will be placing Halo, her 10-year old deaf wheaten.

Angie Anastasia announced she has the patterns for the 2017 quilt and that Bill Pool does know someone who will put it together and quilt it once the squares are done. Several people said they will be happy to do counted cross-stitch square. Pandy Broyles mentioned she also knows someone who might be willing to help.

Rita Adler reported that the one thing our calendar project needs is a photographer. Several people suggested either Elayne Snell or Sonny Bowles. She also suggested an 18-month calendar beginning June, 2016, so they would sell at the Specialty.

Show Chair Sue Stacy announced she is still waiting for final approval from the AKC now that any problems they had with the application had been fixed. She also announced that Cliff Norman had asked to be replaced as Coordinator of the Sanctioned "B" Match because of a scheduling conflict. Cheryl Bates has agreed to take on the position, AKC has been notified, and their final approval has been received. Barb Zink told Cheryl she will be happy to help where she can. Sue also said she has been working on the Premium and is awaiting several

necessary items which Pam has assured her will be available once the National Specialty is done, probably mid-October.

Sue handed out copies of the banquet menus from Hope Hotel. Pam had suggested a plated dinner rather than a buffet because after being on their feet all day, people will want to sit and not have to go through a buffet line and it was agreed this would be the best option and that the Board decided on two entrees - oven roasted Salmon fillet and New York Strip Steak. The total cost with tax and gratuity should be about \$32, the same as last year.

Sue also announced that the Board decided to raise entry fees, especially since most clubs are charging \$30 a class. Entry fees have not been raised since September, 2011. The new fee structure is as follows:

SWEEPS -- \$10 per puppy plus all puppies MUST be entered in a Regular class.

ALL PUPPY CLASSES (6-under 18 months) -- \$20

BRED BY EXHIBITOR -- \$20

ALL OTHER REGULAR CLASSES (AMERICAN BRED, OPEN, BEST OF BREED AND VETERANS) - \$24.

Sue also announced that we are in need of someone to handle publicity in Dayton. No one volunteered.

Gary asked, and it was agreed, that the awarding of the Good Sportsmanship Award should be delayed until the September meeting because of the Chaos that reigns at the Winery in August.

Stacy Sayre introduced her guest, Kathy Ball. Kathy works with Stacy and has a Scottie girl named Paisley.

Gary said we need a location for the Christmas party in December. Nothing has been decided for the November meeting. The October meeting will be the 31<sup>st</sup> at the Hope Hotel. Pam will send directions.

LeeAnn Whaley announced that her Scottie Karley has achieved a certification in nose work and that there will be a seminar in October in Dayton. Pam will email information to all the members.

Barb Zink moved and Susan Moloney seconded a motion that the meeting be adjourned. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
