

About the 2017 Top 20 Jubilee

Purpose:

The purpose of the Top Twenty event is to showcase excellence in Scottish Terriers. This event is a part of the STCA rotating national specialty weekend and is intended to educate and entertain judges, exhibitors, breeders and fanciers. This event provides special recognition to those Scottish Terriers with the most outstanding records in the show ring during the previous calendar year, together with their breeders, trainers, handlers and owners. The event provides a continuing incentive to strive for Scottish Terriers to excel in structure, movement, temperament and conformation according to the American Kennel Club (AKC) standard.

Using a scale of points, each dog is evaluated according to how closely it conforms to the breed standard. This procedure is not available at any AKC show and allows the spectators an opportunity to evaluate the dogs, scoring them at the same to see how individual views can produce a consensus decision, which can then be compared to their own impressions. To that end, this procedure is written to exhibit each dog, individually for evaluation. These dogs are deserving of their exclusive recognition for their accomplishments in the previous year.

Eligibility to Compete:

There are no eligibility requirements other than being named among the final Top 20 Scottish Terriers in (AKC) conformation competition. Any Scottish Terrier who is ranked in Top 20) for the previous year in regards to Scottish Terrier Club of America (STCA):

- 1. *Lloyd points*;
- 2. Blueberry Group Points;
- 3. Breed Points;
- 4. Novice Owner Handler (NOH; and/or
- 5. Top 10 Canadian Kennel Club breed points. Scottish Terriers from other countries who can demonstrate they are in the Top 5 rankings for their home country are also eligible.

Process:

Each Dog is judge individually by three mystery judges who are knowledgeable about Scottish Terriers. The judges must consist of the following:

- 1) A breeder with 10 or more years of experience;
- 2) A judge either a breed specialist, terrier group or other AKC, FCI or recognized national or international judge;
- 3) A handler who has shown Scottish Terriers with success. Judges are chosen by the Top 20 committee. Their names

remain anonymous and are not announced until the Top 20 event begins. Judges are not paid for judging the Top 20 event.

If selected, they judge Scottish Terriers at the event out of respect for the breed and because it is honor to judge the event.

Judges scores are kept secret. Only the winner's name and the people's choice winner's name are announced.
