Bladder Screening Clinics 2020
Reminder from the STCA Health Trust Fund

Notice: The HTF has extended the deadline for the submission of proposals for the 2020 Bladder Screening Clinics. STCA Regional Clubs will now have until December 31, 2019 to submit a proposal to the HTF for a clinic to be held during 2020. Be sure to make plans for this opportunity to hold an important clinic for the health of your Scotties!

The HTF will be donating \$2000 per club for this project, for up to three Regional Clubs. The Clubs must submit a proposal to the HTF for final determination of which three clubs will be awarded this funding.

If you are interested in participating, be sure to contact your club member (Barb Zink for STCGD) who is organizing the clinic. This will be a chance to get a professional bladder ultrasound screening on your Scotties at a substantially discounted cost to you. You do not need to be a club member or an STCA member to participate.

Remember: Early detection is your best defense against Bladder Cancer in our Scotties!

Street parking is available in front of the house but there are a lot of steps to the front door. If you can't manage the steps please use the alley parking described as follows: Belmonte Park NORTH is a one way street off Grand Ave one block west of Stoddard Ave at Grandview Hospital main entrance. The alley behind my house makes a loop (both entrance and exit) on the left side of the first block of Belmonte Park NORTH. There is room for about 5 cars behind my garage on the alley. DIRECTIONS

Coming from the North on I75 – take exit 54A – Main St/Grand Ave. It will look as though you are going back up onto the highway but follow the signs for Grand Ave and Grandview Hospital. You will cross both Main St and Forest Ave. Across from the hospital main entrance on Grand, turn left on Stoddard Ave and bear to the right. 221 BPE is on the right just before the second large traffic circle.

Coming From the East on State Route 4 –take I75 South (Cincinnati) at the junction. Immediately you will see Exit 54A, Main St/Grand Ave. It will look as though you are going back up onto the highway but follow the signs for Grand Ave and Grandview Hospital. You will cross both Main St and Forest Ave. Across from the hospital main entrance on Grand, turn left on Stoddard Ave and bear to the right. 221 BPE is on the right just before the second large traffic circle.

Coming from the South on I75 – take exit 54A – Main St. Move to the far LEFT turn lane. You are now under the highway overpass. Turn LEFT again. It will look as though you are going back up onto the highway but follow the signs to the right for Grand Ave and Grandview Hospital. You will cross both Main St and Forest Ave. Across from the hospital main entrance on Grand, turn left on Stoddard Ave and bear to the right. 221 BPE is on the right just before the second large traffic circle.

Coming from the East OR West on SR 35. – Take I75 NORTH-bound. Take exit 54A – Main St. Move to the far LEFT turn lane. You are now under the highway overpass. Turn LEFT again. It will look as though you are going back up onto the highway but follow the signs to the right for Grand Ave and Grandview Hospital. You will cross both Main St and Forest Ave. Across from the hospital main entrance on Grand, turn left on Stoddard Ave and bear to the right. 221 BPE is on the right just before the second large traffic circle
