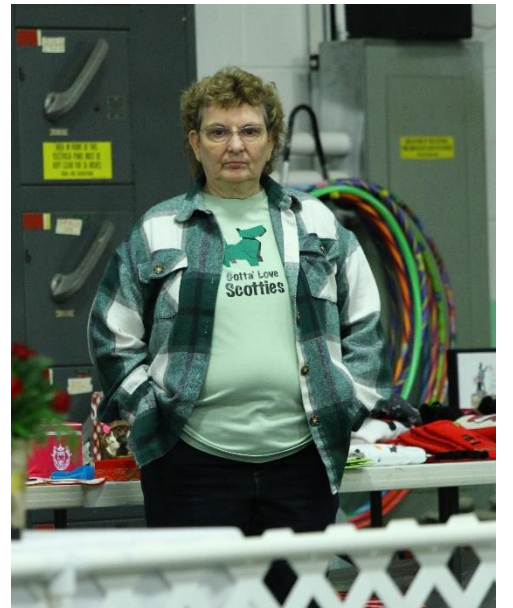
Updating Club Archives

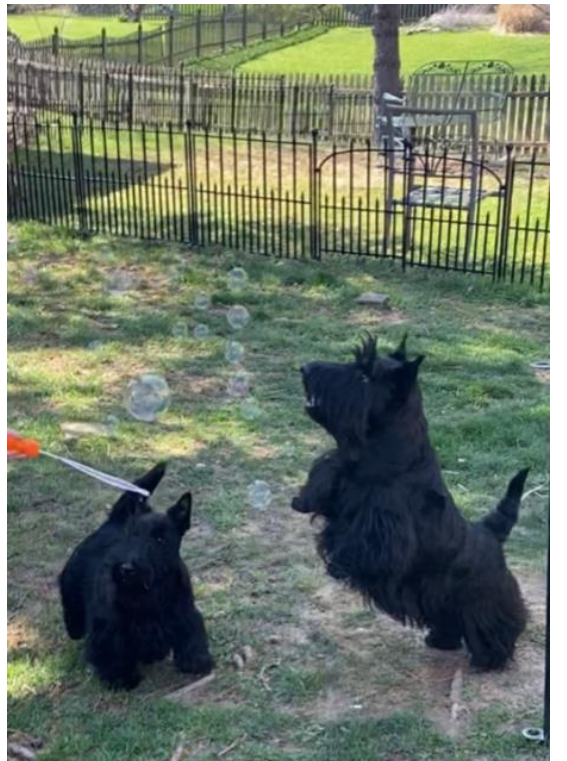
As STCGD Historian, I wish to thank all of those photographers, past and present, who have contributed to the Club Archives.

I will bring my laptop and the CD to show during lunch at the meeting April 29 in case there are some of you who did not get the opportunity to see it at the Specialty.

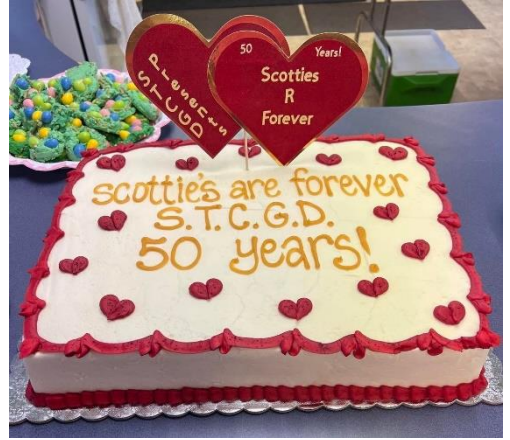

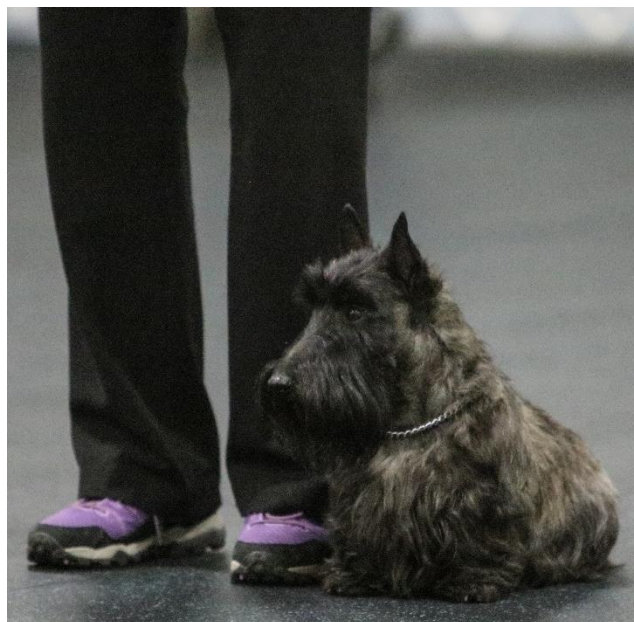
Ike Makes News Earning Groundbreaking Title for Scotties
